If in 1797, Napoleon did not conquer Venice maybe, in 1989, a series of mysterious crimes would have not happened in Murano, in the new Republic, led by the ruthless Doge, Anselmo Biaberini.

Zero-budget full-length movie film made in Veneto and present at the Venice Film Market of the 70th Venice International Film Festival.

Impossible Venice (90') directed by William Carrer, with Francesco Wolf, Davide Strava e Roberto Vertieri. Set in a 1987 impossible Venice, this featured film tells about a new Republic born from the Venetian revolt against Napoleon Bonaparte, and led by a new Doge, Anselmo Biaberini. Under his dictatorship, the inquiries to find out the instigator of a series of mysterious murders involving several glass-masters that happened in Murano, are conducted.

Head of the inquiry is Leonardo Rizzi (Francesco Wolf), Provveditor Capo de la Quarantia al Civil e al Criminal dello Stato Veneto who, with his Fanti, Avanzi (Davide Strava) and Giustini (Roberto Vertieri), has to constantly compare the two contrasting worlds that characterize the Republic: on the one hand the dictatorship; on the other the hidden world of the rebels who delude themselves to fight for the ideals of freedom and independence. Weaves of personal stories and intersections of both worlds, will lead the epilogue and the unveiling of the much sought-motive, who turns out to not be part of the real world.
